The determination of the Tribunal was as follows:

Determination:

The first, second, third and fourth named appellants not being in attendance and the Tribunal being satisfied that they were properly on notice of the hearing the Tribunal finds that their appeals under both the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 and the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005 fail for want of prosecution.

The Tribunal is satisfied, based on the uncontroverted evidence of the fifth named appellant, that the fifth named appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period. It should be noted that payments from the social insurance fund are limited to a maximum of €600-00 per week.
