There was an unexplained absence of the Respondent

The Tribunal being satisfied that the Respondent was properly notified of the hearing and having adduced the uncontroverted evidence of the Claimant found that the Claimant is entitled to payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following information.

The Claimant was laid off on 3rd May 2008 and served a form RP9 on 24th March 2009.

An issue arose concerning unpaid leave taken by the Claimant on several occasions when he would return to Poland. The Tribunal considered Rule 8(c) of the Third Schedule to the 1967 Act and finds those periods to be reckonable service.
