Based on the uncontested evidence of the appellant the Tribunal is satisfied that a redundancy situation existed. Accordingly, the Tribunal determines that he is entitled to a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 To 2007, based on the following information:
