The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

Determination

The Tribunal accepts that a redundancy situation existed. The Tribunal finds that the work carried out by the appellant's initial employer was taken over by the respondent and that there was no break in the appellant's service. The Tribunal awards the appellant a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following information:

Date of Birth: Date of commencement of employment: Date of termination of employment: Gross Weekly Pay: 7 December 1957 28 August 2006 15 September 2008 €680.00

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

It should be noted that payments from the social insurance fund are limited to a maximum of $\notin 600.00$ per week.

The Tribunal awards the appellant €680.00 being one weeks wages, he was given one weeks notice, under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employments Acts, 1973 to 2005.
