The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

The appellant withdrew his appeal under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005, at the outset of the hearing.

The respondent conceded that a redundancy situation had occurred and that the appellant was entitled to a redundancy payment.

The Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, based on the following information:

Date of Birth: 14th August 1985
Date of Commencement: 24th October 2005
Date of Termination: 2nd December 2008

Gross Weekly Pay: €641.26

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period. It should be noted that a statutory weekly ceiling of €600.00 applies to payments from the Social Insurance Fund.
