## **Determination:**

On the basis of the evidence adduced from both sides at this hearing, the Tribunal believes that while the respondent stated that they were in a position to offer some work to the appellant, they were nonetheless unable to offer the appellant thirteen weeks full time work.

The Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:
