The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

The respondent conceded that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy payment. The respondent's business is delivering blocks to the construction industry. When the level of work decreased he placed the appellant on a three-day week. However, after a period of time the respondent had no other option but to make the appellant's position redundant.

Determination:

The Tribunal awards the appellant a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth: 22nd August 1968
Date of Commencement: 2nd June 1998
Date of Termination: 4th March 2009

Gross Weekly Pay: €470.00

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social

Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
