The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

By letter dated 21st December 2006 the appellant's were informed of the winding down of the respondent company and were given six weeks notice of being made redundant. The company ceased trading on 10th February 2007.

Determination:

The Tribunal is satisfied that the appellants are entitled to a Redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following:

dismissed as the appellants were given the required notice by letter dated 21st December 2006.
