Determination

The Tribunal having heard the uncontested evidence of the appellant is satisfied that a genuine redundancy situation exists. Accordingly the Tribunal awards the appellant a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2007 based on the following information:

Date of commencement of employment:	1 March 2005
Date of termination of employment:	20 March 2009
Gross Weekly Pay:	€1270.40
