The Managing Director of the respondent company stated that he did not dispute the appellant's appeal for a redundancy payment, but stated that he could not afford to pay it. The company was not in liquidation. The Managing Director was hoping work would come up. The appellant's employment was terminated due to lack of work.

## Determination:

The Tribunal finds that a redundancy situation existed and that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, based on the following information:
