The Tribunal were satisfied that the Respondent Company had been dissolved and therefore could not be heard.

Claimant's case

The claimant stated that she was made redundant on 15th Oct. 2008. However she had been employed for less than 104 weeks by the respondent and was not entitled to a redundancy lump sum.

The Claimant stated that she received time off for holidays but was not paid for these periods of time.

The claimant stated that she did not receive notice of redundancy and was not paid wages in lieu of notice.
The Tribunal makes an award of €1,980.00 for holiday pay due under the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997.
The Tribunal makes an award of €330.00 as payment of notice under the Minimum Notice And Terms Of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.
