## The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

#### **Determination:**

Based on the uncontested evidence of the appellant the Tribunal finds that he is entitled to a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth: 16<sup>th</sup> August 1968
Date of Commencement: 9<sup>th</sup> November 2005
Date of Termination: 17<sup>th</sup> December 2008

Gross Weekly Pay: €558.50

It should be noted that payments from the social insurance fund are limited to a maximum of €600.00 per week.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
