Determination

The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent was properly notified of this hearing. Neither they nor representatives on their behalf appeared for this case. Having considered the uncontested evidence of the appellant, the Tribunal finds that she is entitled to a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:

Date of birth	16 th September 1977
Date employment commenced	10 th February 2003
Date employment ceased	7 th November 2008
Gross weekly pay	€646.81

It should be noted that a statutory weekly ceiling of €600.00 applies to payments from the Social Insurance Fund.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
