Determination

The appellant's representative formally withdrew the appeals under the Payment of Wages Act 1991.

The Tribunal notes that an effort was made by the respondent to comply with the requirements

under the Terms of Employment (Information) Act, 1994 and 2001 but finds that there was not full compliance. An award is therefore required, but the maximum would not be appropriate. The Tribunal varies the recommendations of the Rights Commissioner under the Terms of Employment (Information) Act, 1994 and 2001 and awards compensation to the appellants as follows;
