This appeals came before the Tribunal by way of the appellant appealing against the decisions of the Rights Commissioner under the Payment of Wages Act, 1991, reference r-069232-pw-08/EOS.

The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

Determination

The Tribunal cannot hear the appeal as it has no option but to decline jurisdiction. S. 7(2) of the Payment of Wages Act, 1991, provides:

"An appeal under this section shall be initiated by a party by his giving, within 6 weeks of the date on which the decision to which it relates was communicated to him-

(a) a notice in writing to the Tribunal containing such particulars (if any) as may	be specified in
regulations under subsection (3) and stating the intention of the party concerned to	appeal against
the decision, and	

(b) a copy of the notice to the other party concerned."

The Tribunal is not satisfied that s.7 (2) (b) above has been complied with and therefore has no alternative but to find that it does not have jurisdiction to hear the appeal under the Payment of Wages Act, 1991, against Rights Commissioner Recommendation r-069232-pw-08/EOS.
