Determination

The respondent conceded that the appellant was dismissed by reason of redundancy. Accordingly the Tribunal determines that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2007 based on the following information.

Date of termination of employment:	19 December 2008
Gross weekly pay:	€600

The award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

Furthermore the Tribunal awards the appellant the sum of €1200.00 being the equivalent of two weeks pay owing under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts 1973 to 2005.
