Determination

Based on the uncontested evidence of the appellant the Tribunal finds that appellant A is entitled to an award of €750.00 being the equivalent of one week's pay under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts 1973 to 2005. The Tribunal makes a further award of €1200.00 being the equivalent of 8 days holiday pay owing under the Organisation of Working Time Act 1997.

Based on the uncontested evidence of the appellant the Tribunal finds that appellant B is entitled to an award of €1057.69 being the equivalent of one week's pay under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts 1973 to 2005. The Tribunal makes a further award of €2538.45 being the equivalent of 12 days pay owing under the Organisation of Working Time Act 1997.
