The decision of the Tribunal was as follows: -

Determination

The appellant served the RP9 form on the respondent but did not receive a response in writing. The Tribunal awards the appellant a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth:	28 th May 1974
Date of Commencement:	30th January 2006
Date of Termination:	14 th May 2009
Gross Weekly Pay:	€660.00

The award is based on the appellant having been in insurable employment during this period. It should be noted that a statutory weekly ceiling of $\in 600.00$ applies to payments from the

Social Insurance Fund.

The Tribunal also finds that the appellant is entitled to his statutory Public Holiday entitlements, therefore awards the appellant the sum of \notin 264.00 being the equivalent of 2 days pay under the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997.
