## **Determination:**

Having heard evidence the Tribunal is satisfied that the appellant was dismissed by reason of redundancy. The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent ceased trading and the respondent is unable to pay redundancy. Accordingly, the Tribunal determines that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on her continuous service and the following information:

Date of Birth:10th June 1973Date of commencement of employment:11th April 2005Date of notice:11th March 2009Date of termination of employment:25th March 2009Gross weekly pay, based on a five-day week:€666.50

The appeal under the Minimum Notice and Terms Of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005, succeeds and the Tribunal awards the appellant the sum of €1,333.00, as compensation in lieu of notice.

The appeal under the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997, succeeds and the Tribunal awards the appellant the sum of €1,333.00.

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These awards are made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

Please note that there is a weekly ceiling of €600.00 on all awards made from the Social insurance Fund
