Determination

This is a claim for implementation of a Right's Commissioner's recommendation r-055018-te-07/SR dated 15th February 2008. There was no appearance by or on behalf of the respondent company. The Tribunal was satisfied that it had been properly put on notice of the hearing.

The Tribunal, is satisfied that the recommendation of the Rights Commissioner has not been carried out by the respondent in accordance with its terms or at all and it is further satisfied that the prescribed six-week time limit for bringing an appeal against the recommendation has expired and no such appeal has been brought. Accordingly, the Tribunal makes a determination to like effect as the Rights Commissioner's recommendation that the respondent pays the appellant €1,700 under the Terms of Employment (Information) Act, 1994 and 2001.
