The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The appellant sought a redundancy award based on an employment which commenced on 27 November 2004 but from which he was only paid up to Friday 26 September 2008 because his employment ended due to redundancy. His gross weekly pay was assessed at €619.22 after documentation was examined.

No-one attended the Tribunal hearing on behalf of the respondent.

Determination:

Under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum based on the following details:

Date of birth:	19 July 1957
Date of commencement:	27 November 2004
Date of termination:	26 September 2008
Gross weekly pay:	€619.22

It should be noted that payments from the social insurance fund are limited to a maximum of €600.00 per week.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
