Determination:

There was no appearance or representation for the respondent. The Tribunal are satisfied that proper notification was sent to the respondent. Based on the uncontroverted evidence, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth: 21st January 1968
Date of Commencement: 5th February 2005
Date of Notice: 29th August 2008
Date of Termination: 29th August 2008
Gross Weekly Pay: €810.00

It should be noted that a statutory weekly ceiling of €600.00 currently applies to payments from the Social Insurance Fund. This award is made subject to the appellant fulfilling current social welfare requirements in relation to PRSI contributions.
