The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

The Tribunal noted that the respondent was conceding this appeal. Having satisfied itself that the appellant's employment was terminated by way of redundancy the Tribunal allows the appeal and awards the appellant a statutory lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following:

Date of Birth: 7 April 1960
Date of commencement: 30 April 2001
Date of Termination: 17 April 2009
Gross Weekly Wage: €610.00

Statutory redundancy payments are subject to a weekly ceiling of €600.00

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment during the relevant period in accordance with the Social Welfare Acts.

The appeal under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005 is allowed and the appellant is awarded €1220.00 as compensation for outstanding notice.
