The decision of the Tribunal was as follows: -

Determination

The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent had been properly notified of the hearing. Notice of the hearing date had been served by registered and ordinary pre-paid post at the address of the respondent company's registered office and that address was confirmed to be the current address as per a search at the Companies Register Office website conducted on the morning of the hearing by the secretary to the division. The secretary to the division also attempted telephone contact to both the telephone number provided on the Form T1A and the number on the headed paper of the respondent but both calls went to an automated recording. The Tribunal notes that the respondent had filed an extensive T2 with the Tribunal. Based on the uncontroverted evidence of the appellant the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy

Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth	5 th October 1980
Employment commenced	4 th July 2000
Employment ended	17 th April 2009
Gross weekly pay	€486.04

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
