The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

The Tribunal is satisfied that the named agent was properly notified of this hearing. There was no appearance from him on the day of the hearing. The Tribunal recognises he is not the legal respondent in this case and is not personally responsible or liable for the actions of the appellant's former employer in this case.

The appellant's T1-A form was received by its secretariat on 11 December 2009. The appellant's date of termination was stated as 30 June 2008 on that form. Having considered the circumstances of this case the Tribunal gave itself jurisdiction to hear this case allowing for the "reasonable cause" clause.

Following further submissions from the appellant the Tribunal allows the appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 and awards her a statutory lump sum under those Acts and based on the following:
