## **Determination:**

The respondent having conceded liability in this matter, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria.

Date of Birth Employment commenced Employment ended Gross weekly pay 18 May 1946 23 May 1996 16 January 2009 €660-00

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period. It being accepted that the appellant received two weeks' notice of termination the Tribunal further awards €2,640-00, being four weeks' pay, under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005. It should be noted that payments from the social insurance fund are limited to a maximum of €600-00 per week
