Determination

It was common case that a redundancy situation existed. The appellant was not paid all his redundancy lump sum because the respondent could not pay. The Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum based on the following information:

Date of Birth:	20 March 1948
Date Employment Began:	01 October 1997
Date Employment Ended:	31 December 2007
Gross Weekly Pay:	€490.00

A credit is given to the respondent for the €6000.00 already paid to the appellant.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
