The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

There was no appearance by, or representation on behalf of, the respondent company. The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent company was on notice of the hearing. Having heard the uncontested evidence of the appellant the Tribunal is satisfied that a redundancy situation existed and that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, based on the following information:

Date of Birth: 5<sup>th</sup> April 1976  
Date of Commencement: 5<sup>th</sup> June 2006  
Date of Termination: 23<sup>rd</sup> January 2009  
Weekly Gross Pay: €551.00

It should be noted that this award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

The Tribunal refuses the appellant's application to add a claim under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005, as the respondent has not been put on notice of the claim.
