The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

At the outset the appellant withdrew his appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 To 2007.

Having considered the evidence presented to it the Tribunal is satisfied that the appellant requested his redundancy entitlements in the course of his lay off. He ultimately got paid his redundancy monies, although there was some delay in obtaining same.

The legislation stipulates that in circumstances where an employee seeks redundancy entitlements whilst on lay off he cannot work out his minimum notice and therefore cannot be paid in lieu thereof.
