The decision of the Tribunal was as follows: -

The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent was duly notified of the hearing.

Appellant's Case

The respondent went into receivership in October 2009. The appellant signed and submitted the RP50 form but the respondent failed to sign it. The appellant returned the RP50 form on the 14th of July to the respondent for signature but they failed to return it to her.

The appellant was given notice on the 2^{nd} of October that the branch of the respondent she was working in would be closing; there was no definitive date for the closure. The last day the appellant worked was the 27^{th} of February 2009. The respondent requested her not to take her holidays as they were busy with the closure but informed her they would pay all holidays due to her with her last pay, the respondent failed to do this.

Determination:

Based on the uncontested evidence of the appellant the Tribunal finds that the appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 succeeds and awards the appellant a Redundancy Lump sum under the based on the following criteria:

Date of birth	12 th July 1983
Date employment commenced	2 nd October 2006
Date employment ceased Gross weekly pay	27 th March 2009 €519.05
This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.	

The Tribunal finds that the claim under the Organisation of Working Time Act 1997 succeeds and awards the appellant the sum of \notin 276.13 being the equivalent of 2.66 days pay.
