The decision of the Tribunal was as follows: -

## Appellant's Case

The appellant was informed as he was leaving for his Christmas holidays on Friday the 19<sup>th</sup> of December 2008 that there was no further work available for him. The appellant was paid his two weeks Annual Leave and on his return submitted an RP50 to the respondent. The respondent did not complete the RP50 accurately so the appellants Redundancy was not paid.

### **Determination**

The Tribunal finds that the appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 To 2007 succeeds. The appellant is entitled to a Redundancy Lump sum based on the following criteria;

Date of Birth: 26<sup>th</sup> November 1970
Date of Commencement: 4<sup>th</sup> September 2006
Date of Termination: 7<sup>th</sup> January 2009

Gross Weekly Pay: €490.00

The award is based on the appellant having been in insurable employment during this period.

The Tribunal awards the claimant €980.00 being the equivalent to two weeks' pay, under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.
