The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

At the out set the claim under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 was withdrawn.

Determination:

The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondents were properly notified of this hearing. Neither they nor representatives on their behalf appeared for this case. Having considered submissions from the appellant, the Tribunal allows the appeal under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2001 and awards the appellant € 2,346.16 as compensation for four weeks notice.

The Tribunal also awards the appellant the sum of € 597.10, this being seven days annual leave, under the Organisation Of Working Time Act, 1997.
