## **Determination:**

The respondent having conceded liability in this matter, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria.

Date of Birth Employment commenced Employment ended Gross weekly pay 20 November 1956 21 September 1999 27 April 2009 €793-95 There was a period of non-reckonable service, by reason of lay-off, from 18 July 2008 until 27 April 2009.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period. It should be noted that payments from the social insurance fund are limited to a maximum of €600-00 per week
