The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

Ms. C conceded that the claimants had an entitlement to a minimum notice payment.

Claimant B gave evidence of an outstanding entitlement under the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997.

Determination:

The Tribunal awards Claimant A the sum of €1,658.22 (being the equivalent of four weeks grosspay) under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.

The Tribunal awards Claimant B the sum of €1,192.60 (being the equivalent of four weeks gross pay) under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.

The Tribunal also awards Claimant B the sum of €1,082.88 (being the equivalent of 18.16 days gross pay) under the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997.
