The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

The liquidator conceded that the appellant was entitled to a redundancy payment.

Determination:

The Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth:	14 th February 1975
Date of Commencement:	20 th April 2006
Date of Termination:	9 th February 2009
Gross Weekly Pay:	€1000.00

It should be noted that payments from the social insurance fund are limited to a maximum of €600.00 per week.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period
