The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

Having heard the brief uncontested evidence of both appellants the Tribunal is satisfied that their employment ceased without proper notice and with outstanding holidays entitlements. Accordingly, both appellants are awarded €350.00 each as compensation for one week's notice under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.

The appeals under the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997 succeed and the first named appellant is awarded €630.00 and the second named appellant is awarded €945.00 as compensation under that Act.
