The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

## **Appellant's Case**

The appellant was informed that the respondent was closing down and she was being made redundant. After informing the appellant they would pay her redundancy the respondent changed their mind stating they did not have the funds to pay her redundancy. The appellant received her minimum notice entitlement.

## **Determination:**

The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent was properly notified of this hearing. Neither they nor representatives on their behalf appeared for this case.

The Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a Redundancy Lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:

Date employment commenced1st October 2006Date employment ceased14th March 2009 Gross weekly pay

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
