The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

Determination

The Tribunal were satisfied that the respondent was on notice of the hearing. The appellant gave direct sworn evidence during which he produced a letter from Revenue that provided his commencement and termination of his employment with the respondent. The Tribunal amended the T1A to reflect these dates. Based on the uncontested evidence of the appellant the Tribunal awards him a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth:12th October 1968Date of Commencement:16th April 2001Date of Termination:25th July 2008Gross Weekly Pay:€500.00
