The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

## **Appellant's Case**

The appellant commenced employment on the 11<sup>th</sup> of October 2004. The respondent gave her the dismissal notice on the 5<sup>th</sup> of February 2009 to finish on the 27<sup>th</sup> of February 2009. The appellant took a 20% decrease to her gross salary due to the difficulty the respondent company was in. The appellant believed this salary reduction was temporary one and agreed to it on that basis. The respondent agreed that the appellant's Redundancy would be calculated based on her original salary.

# Respondent's Case

Due to the difficulty the respondent company was in he was forced to reduce the appellant's salary by 20% in November 2008. The Respondent has conceded that a Redundancy situation existed but has arranged to pay the lump sum based on the appellant's reduced salary.
