Appellant's Case

The appellant's worked for the respondent as bricklayers. The foreman on the site they were working on approached them after lunch and informed them there was no further work available for them. The appellants submitted RP77 forms to the respondent but did not receive any correspondence from them in relation to their redundancy.

Determination

The Tribunal find that the appellants were made redundant on the 12th June 2008.

Appellant 1

The Tribunal awards the appellant a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth: 12th August 1975
Date of Commencement: 4th September 2003
Date of Termination: 12th June 2008
Gross Weekly Pay: €1500.00

The award is based on the appellant having been in insurable employment during this period. It should be noted that a statutory weekly ceiling of €600.00 applies to payments from the Social Insurance Fund.

Appellant 2

The Tribunal awards the appellant a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth: 28th August 1975
Date of Commencement: 4th September 2003
Date of Termination: 12th June 2008
Gross Weekly Pay: €1500.00

The award is based on the appellant having been in insurable employment during this period. It should be noted that a statutory weekly ceiling of €600.00 applies to payments from the Social Insurance Fund.
