The claim under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005 succeeds and the Tribunal awards the first named appellant € 774.52 being the equivalent of two weeks pay and the second named appellant €507.98 being the equivalent of two weeks pay.	
The Tribunal also awards the first named appellant €774.52 and the second named appellant €507.98 under the Organisation of Working Time Act 1997.
