The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

Appellant's Case

The appellant told the Tribunal that he commenced employment on 28 June 2006. He started work at 9a.m. and finished between 6.00pm and 7.00pm. He worked a five-day week and the hours he worked varied from twenty to fifty hours a week. He did not have a break in service apart from his holidays. His employment with the respondent terminated on 23 December 2008.

Determination

On the uncontested evidence of the appellant the Tribunal finds that he is entitled to a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:-

Date of birth	22 January 1969
Date employment commenced	28 August 2006
Date employment ended	23 December 2008
Gross weekly pay	€600.00

This award is made subject to the appellant being in insurable employment during the relevant period under the Social Welfare Acts.
