This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

The Tribunal find that the appellant was made redundant without notice on the  $23^{rd}$  of December 2008 and allows the appeal under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005. The Tribunal award the appellant €713.98 as compensation for two week's notice.
