The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

Determination

The respondent was placed in receivership on 23 February 2010. The appellant had mistakenly believed that by signing the RP50 his appeal had been dealt with. The receiver conceded the redundancy appeal. The Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:-

Date of birth	06 April 1981
Date employment commenced	17 July 2006
Date employment ceased	19 June 2009
Gross weekly pay	€400.00

This award is being made subject to the appellant being in insurable employment during the relevant period under the Social Welfare Acts.
