Determination

The respondent conceded that a redundancy situation existed. Accordingly the Tribunal determines that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2007 based on the following information:

Date of Birth:	11 December 1985
Date of commencement of employment:	1 August 2003
Date of termination of employment:	15 March 2009
Gross weekly pay:	€627.74

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
