The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The appellant sought a redundancy award on the grounds that he had been employed (as a trainee roofer) by the respondent from 4 April 2005 to Friday 18 July 2008 when his employment ended due to redundancy. His gross weekly pay was €340.00.

No evidence was offered to the Tribunal on behalf of the respondent.

**Determination:**

On the uncontested evidence of the appellant, the Tribunal makes a finding, under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum based on the following details:

Date of birth: 11 October 1978  
Date of commencement: 04 April 2005  
Date of termination: 18 July 2008  
Gross weekly pay: €340.00

It should be noted that payments from the social insurance fund are limited to a maximum of €600.00 per week.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
