The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The appellant sought a redundancy award on the grounds that he had been employed from February 2001 to Friday 18 July 2008 when his employment ended due to redundancy. He stated that there had been no breaks in his service. The only written statement that he provided indicated a gross weekly pay of €485.20.

No evidence was offered to the Tribunal on behalf of the respondent.

Determination:

On the uncontested evidence of the appellant, the Tribunal makes a finding, under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum based on the following details:

Date of birth: 11 October 1966
Date of commencement: 15 February 2001
Date of termination: 18 July 2008
Gross weekly pay: €485.20

It should be noted that payments from the social insurance fund are limited to a maximum of €600.00 per week.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
