Having heard and considered the brief evidence of the appellant the Tribunal is satisfied that her employment terminated by the respondent by way of redundancy and without proper notice. Accordingly, her appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 is allowed and she is awarded a statutory lump sum under those Acts and based on the following:

Date of Birth: 7 January 1983
Date of Commencement: 18 September 2006
Date of Termination: 3 February 2009

Gross Weekly Wage: €590.00 (per P60 of 2008)

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

The appeal under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005 succeeds and the appellant is awarded €1180.00 in compensation for two weeks notice under those Acts.
