Following doubts raised on the first day as to whether the appellant had received a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts in circumstances where the respondent conceded liability in this matter but asserted inability to pay, the matter was adjourned to seek further information.

It emerged that a cheque had issued to the appellant but had not been received due to some confusion over the appellant's address. The Tribunal, being satisfied that this cheque had not been presented for payment, finds that the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria.
