The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The appellant sought a redundancy lump sum award on the grounds that his employment with the respondent, which commenced on 8 November 2005, ended by reason of redundancy on 28 February 2009 after he had been given notice on 9 January 2009. There had been no breaks in his service in the last three years of his employment. His gross weekly pay was €664.10.

No evidence was offered at the hearing by or on behalf of the respondent.

Determination:

Under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum based on the following details:

Date of commencement:08 November 2005Date of termination:28 February 2009Gross weekly pay:€664.10

It should be noted that payments from the social insurance fund are limited to a maximum of $\notin 600.00$ per week.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
